Theatre Load-In: Thursday, June 1st (approx) as early as possible – we need a volunteer to drive the truck and 3 or 4 volunteers to help lay the floor, hang the set, and place the props. We also need volunteers to "break the set" , unload the truck and return it,

Theatre Dress Rehearsal: Friday, June 2nd , 5:30-10:30pm(approx). Pre-Ballet, Ballet Prep, and Ballet I may arrive at 6:00pm. All young dancers may leave Dress Rehearsal at the end of Act II (approx. 9:00pm) unless they are in Act III.
